“Altzaney”

This documentary, by acclaimed director Nino Orjonikidze, is about the traditional social dynamics in a small village in the Caucasus region. The film centers around Altzaney, an 87-year old woman, who deals with lives and deaths of the local people and is the village elder entrusted with resolving daily problems of the community. “Altzaney” was an official 2009 entry of Georgia in the International Leipzig Festival for Documentary and Animated Film, the largest German and second largest European documentary film festival. “When Clocks Stop”

This poignant film, by director Tiko Nachkebia, is about the Georgian Public Broadcast Station, the television channel established during the time of the Soviet Union, and the changes in the country that have affected the media organization since independence.
