## ***“The Women From Georgia”***

Directed by Levan Koguashvili, this movie is a collage of stories of Georgian women who work in the US as caregivers to the elderly and a biting critique of how their employers treat their parents as they grow old. The Georgian women talk a lot, and they argue vehemently, which is understandable because most of them only have one day off during the week. In their off days they meet to discuss their work and their families in Georgia, sharing sentiments even to the point of strong disagreement. But these women are just happy that they have their jobs. They need to earn money to send home to feed their families, and, as what usually happens, to support their families’ families, who seem to be growing bigger and bigger the longer they stay abroad. “The Women from Georgia” is a poignant masterful work, which reflects the realities of migrant labor—a topic that Filipino audiences will no doubt appreciate and relate to.
